# GET ACTIVE IN THE PARK!

## HIKE SHEEPSKIN TRAIL

Length: Approximately 3.7 miles | Level of Difficulty: Easy - Medium

Sheepskin Trail is a lightly trafficked trail located near Brownfield, PA. It is best used during the months of March through November. This is a great trail for walking, running, or biking. The route features wildflowers, creeks, bridges, and gorgeous views. It is a paved trail that is wheelchair accessible and contains many benches and picnic areas if you need to rest. Trails on the Trail dog park is at the north end of the trail and Hutchison Park is on the trail's south end.
