Lake Erie Community Park is a 125-acre area spanning nearly 1 mile of the Lake Erie shoreline. The beautification process of this site began in 2013 after Girard Township was awarded ownership of the property to convert the land from a campground to a public park. While there are plans to continue improving the space, it is now a great place to be active and enjoy nature.

HIKE LAKE ERIE COMMUNITY PARK

Length: varies | Level of Difficulty: easy

Lake Erie Community Park has 4 trails ranging in length from 400 yards to 1 mile. Main paths are paved, smaller trails are dirt, gravel, or woodchips. The park is pet-friendly and ADA accessible.
